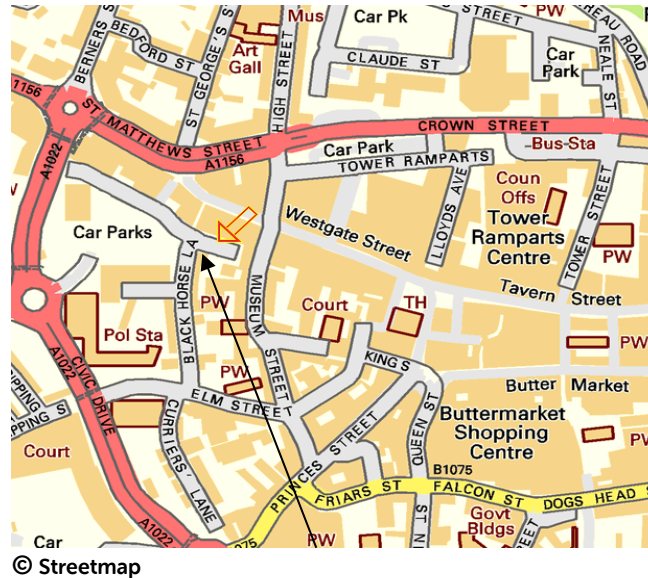

The Chapman Centre is located in the corner of Blackhorse Lane and Chapman Lane in the Ipswich town centre near the St Matthews Street roundabout.



Chapman Lane (at the back of the New Wolsey Theatre) is named after Samuel Belcher Chapman who lived in Ipswich 1822-1880, was a chemist and druggist in Tavern Street, and a generous philanthropist founding the Girl's Industrial Home (1857-1921) in nearby Black Horse Lane.
